Reports-

- <u>Budget</u>. Kim reports no change; received verbal reports from Becky and Bob A.; contact Kim for tool needs; Money is available for training.

Need nonethanol gas, i.e., 95 octane gas which may be purchased at Wilco Farm Store, and Olsen Brothers to name a few – cost is \$49/5 gal.
