Communications Lead: Know in advance which device works best, and where reception is near today's work site. Before leaving the main party, ensure First Aid Lead has written the injury details. Ensure you have a pen, write down what the call-taker tells you. Return quickly to main party and report to Situation Manager.

<ul> <li>911 calls from cell phones can land in a far-away regional center. The call-taker needs the following information immediately:</li> <li>Your wireless phone number in case disconnected</li> <li>The location you're calling from. See below.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Stand in a clear location, hold the radio upright</li> <li>Check radio for correct channel or repeater</li> <li>Wait for 2 seconds after keying the mike, then speak</li> <li>Try at least 3 times, at least 10 seconds apart</li> <li>If needed, move location &amp; change channels</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>What type of emergency you have (medical, require ambulance; injury specifics)</li> </ul>	Forest: Channel, Repeater:	CRGNSA MH Defiance, GP Lookout
