
Directions to Providence Memorial 810 12th St, Hood River, OR 97031

Head East on FS 660 to FS 1310 Rd 9 mi, left on FS 13 for 4.3 mi, left onto Lost Lake Rd for 2.9 mi,

Turn left onto Imai Rd for 0.5 mi, Take the 1st right to stay on Imai Rd, for 0.2 mi, Continue straight 1.3 mi, Turn right at Punchbowl Rd, for 0.2 mi, Slight left onto OR-281 N/Dee Hwy for 5.9 mi

Turn right to stay on OR-281 N/Dee Hwy & Continue to follow OR-281 N for 2.4 mi, Turn right onto OR-281 N/Tucker Rd for 0.8 mi, Turn left to stay on OR-281 N/Tucker Rd for 0.2 mi, Turn left on May St, Right on 12th St
